

Working With Children Check (WWCC) Number Renewal

Having an active WWCC number is a requirement for public ministry within the Archdiocese of Sydney (and a Government requirement for any child related work).

It is vital that all priests maintain a current WWCC number.

The "renew" tab is now live. The Office of Children's Guardian (OCG) will email those who hold a WWCC number three months before their expiry date. Within that email there is a direct link to the website or click here to renew your WWCC number.

Once you have renewed your WWCC number you must advise the Chancery at ministry@sydneycatholic.org or call Maureen Fairbairn on 02 9390 5105 so that your updated details can be recorded. If you are not sure of your number or renewal date, please contact Maureen on the above number.

PLEASE NOTE:

If you have changed your email address without providing redirection advice, you will not receive a renewal reminder. However you can update your details online.

For those who did not provide an email address when they first applied for a WWCC number and subsequently received their WWCC numbers by mail, this option has now ceased. You will not receive a reminder unless you update your details online.
